The individual donor prospect profile template is created to assist your organization with new donor prospects. It is best to learn, understand, and involve your donors so you can know how to engage them in your organization. It is important to appreciate your donors and not only value them for monetary purposes. Part of ensuring value is understanding they are humans first and not money machines.

Remember to include title and post-nominals

Short bio, include date of birth and country of origin

The contact details of the donor/prospect, e.g.

Relationship to Organization

Provide information about the donor/prospect's history with your organization; any previous donations/support made to your organization; the last time the person was contacted; previous attendance at events; any special things to note, etc.

Estimated Wealth

The estimated wealth of the individual/family. Real estate, stocks, annual income, etc.

Political Views

What is their political party? Are they very progressive, moderate, conservative, etc.?

Spouse/Family

Spouse's name, children's names, children's ages Include Spouse's occupation and education history if available

Family History

If donor is wealthy, it is likely they have a family history. Add their family history here.

Education

Educational qualifications and years awarded; Names of universities, name of high school, etc.

Current Position + Employment History

List their current employer and position Include any relevant employment history

Committee or Board Positions
Dullet point list of committee/heard positions
Bullet point list of committee/board positions
Awards/Honors
List awards or honors received
Social Media Handles
Link Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, etc. accounts

Political Contributions Include previous political donations. Use fec.gov to look up individual political contributions. **Charitable Contributions** Platforms like iWave can tell you the donor's previous contributions.
